Diseases and disorders are treated by simply manipulating these vital points, using hands as the primary tool.

While varma is mainly known for martial arts its, diagnostic and therapaeutic values are not widely known. The objective of this oneday workshop is to emphasize on the diagnostic aspect of varma system, specifically using radial artery pulse(naadi).

The workshop will introduce varma naadi based diagnostic techniques, provide scientific validation of the varma naadi, clinical case studies and exposure to the biomedical instruments useful in varma system. The workshop will also include release of a software based varma naadi tutor.

The workshop consists of a set of lecture notes, companion CD and lab demonstrations. These will be supplemented by the lectures of various experts at the workshop. These notes are the efforts of the faculty / experts who have spent their valuable time. These materials will be of immense help for the participants during and after the workshop and for future clinical practices, references and research.

Who can attend: This workshop is aimed at researchers and students pursuing MD(S) and BSMS, and faculty from colleges pursuing research in Siddha and Varma. Biomedical engineering researchers are also encouraged to attend.
